Fact of the Month



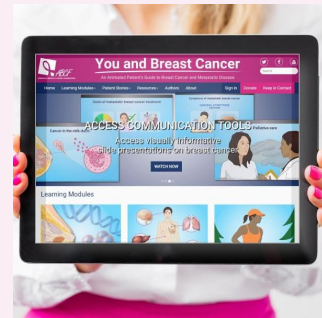
Breast cancer became the **most common cancer globally** as of 2021, accounting for 12% of all new annual cancer cases worldwide.
